SNOW-TOCOL!

Yep, that's a winter weather/protocol pun! We've had our share of it so far in 2025, and fortunately, it looks like we have a bit of a reprieve at least. But that said, the Deacons and I thought it might be helpful to establish a protocol for everyone to follow going forward if snow seems to be looming. So, without further ado:

1. Be sure to check our Facebook Group page, your email, and local news.

These will be the platforms by which we get the word out for cancellations. I will post in the Facebook Group personally, and send an identical email through Breeze. This is another good pitch to make sure you are signed up in the Breeze app! Even if you don't plan to use the app, be sure to give an up to date email to Sharon in the office so that you will get the updates. We will also to continue to post updates on local news channels.

2. When snow is on the ground, please don't drive on the "L" road/sidewalk.

This is the road directly against the sanctuary and the glass doors. This part of the property gets absolutely zero sunlight, and melts VERY slowly. Meaning, if the snow gets packed down and changes to ice, it will melt even slower.

3. In the case of snow/ice, the back sanctuary doors will be CLOSED.

This part of the property also melts slowly, and remains slick and covered for some time. Instead, please plan to enter the building/sanctuary through the side door or the glass doors at the Fellowship Hall.

4. Even if we are open, use your best discretion.

We don't want any accidents from people trying to get to church—even if your smaller roads are still treacherous when main roads are passable. Use your personal discretion and be safe—you can watch the service on Facebook. And to that end...

5. IF we do have to cancel, I will be sure to post the sermon online still.

I genuinely hate not being able to gather for worship and fellowship, but in the case of weather that prevents us from doing so, I will be sure to have some sort of though for you on the Facebook Group page like I did a couple of weeks ago. Please find a time to take that in until we can meet again!
