NEW OFFICE HOURS & LISTENING SESSION AHEAD!

As we prepare to approach June and summer together, I want to acknowledge how busy of a season spring has been for us—in the best way possible! We've got a new Administrative Assistant starting on Monday, June 8—Mrs. Karey Garrison. We are excited for her to join us and continue to invite you to read her info sheet outside of the sanctuary. Let me also invite you to write a card/note of welcome to leave on the desk for her first day!

When Karey starts, there will be a bit of an office hour change that you will need to be aware of. Starting on June 8, the new church office hours will be 8:30-2:30pm Monday-Thursday. The church office will be closed on Fridays. Please be sure to make those changes in your brains as best you can!

And this Sunday, May 31 at 2pm, we will be holding a listening session in the Fellowship Hall about the potential of calling Rev. Amy Hall as Associate Pastor of Community Missions. This is a new consideration for all of us, with this position being the first of its kind in our congregation, so we want to make sure you know what we are considering. Here's some info on what to expect this Sunday:

At the session, we will gather around tables, and I will present some initial information to you about the position. Deacons will position themselves around the room to be present for table conversation, as they have been walking through this process with me since the beginning. I will have the job description available, a breakdown of how the money allocated for it is already provided in our budget, and a written possible projection of what the position might look like to start out, as well as what Amy is already doing in ministry outside of MHBC.

This will be considered as a part-time position, 10 hours per week, and will look to integrate the kind of work Amy is doing in other communities intentionally in our Madison Heights and Old Town communities. It will also mobilize Amy to start training our church members to serve alongside her in this work. We want you to see what she is already doing in Greater Lynchburg, what she will continue to do, and how serving in pastoral leadership here would benefit our MHBC church and community.

To be clear, this is a listening session—not a call. Because this is a pastoral position, the ultimate decision lies with the Church and will require a business session. This Sunday is meant to hear any questions or concerns you have, and to give you the information you need to make an informed decision when the time comes. That said, MHBC leadership has sensed God at work in this process, and we are eager to invite you into it!

I'm excited for all the possibilities and ministries that lie before us in the months ahead. It is a busy season, for sure, but a GOOD one! As always, it is my joy to serve as your pastor. **-Josh**
