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THE GREAT COMMISSION

The Great Commission begins right where we are. Jesus calls us to see the people around us with His love, to care about their needs, and to look for opportunities to connect them with the hope of the gospel. We often don't have to go far to find our mission field as God has already placed people in our neighborhoods, workplaces, schools, and communities who need to experience His love through us.

For MHBC, fulfilling the Great Commission literally started at the end of our driveway this year where neighborhood children waited for the school bus each morning. The Missions Committee saw this as an opportunity to welcome and meet our neighbors without going far. Once a month, rain or shine, the committee served fresh donuts, juice, and coffee to children and their parents at the bus stop. We started with seven children in February and grew to serving 18 children and parents at our final Donut Day of the school year.

Through Donut Day, we learned the names of our neighbors, heard their stories, prayed for them, and had opportunities to invite them to VBS, church, and Klothes for Kids. The children who were hesitant at first gradually warmed up to us, and by the final Donut Day, they were excitedly crossing the street to pick out their donuts.

We have also been partnering with CarePortal, an organization that connects local churches with social services and other family agencies to help vulnerable children and families.

So far this year, we have connected with families and social workers in Amherst County to provide carbon monoxide detectors for a family using alternative heat during the winter, formula for an aunt caring for her niece until WIC assistance began, and a mattress so a child would no longer have to sleep on the floor.

Our committee was also involved in co-hosting a Social Worker Appreciation Breakfast at Amherst DSS with our regional CarePortal office. Through that event, we were able to learn more about the challenges social workers face and share ways our church can support them through practical assistance and prayer.

These are part of the many ways MHBC seeks to live out the Great Commission, both locally and beyond. Every family we help and every neighbor we meet is part of God's ongoing work of drawing people to Himself. **-Amy Hall**
