- The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. **(Psalm 23:1)**
- Jesus wept. **(John 11:35)**
- Do everything in love. **(1 Corinthians 16:14)**
- Rejoice always, pray continually... **(1 Thessalonians 5:16-17)**
- We love because he first loved us. **(1 John 4:19)**

Psalms & Proverbs

- Take delight in the Lord, and He will give you the desires of your heart. **(Psalm 37:4)**
- God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore, we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea...**(Psalm 46:1-2)**
- Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. **(Psalm 103:2-5)**
- Your word is a lamp for my feet, and a light on my path. **(Psalm 119:105)**

Teachings of Jesus

- “This, then, is how you should pray: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.” **(Matthew 6:9-13)**

- “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” **(Matthew 6:19-21)**
- “So do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.” **(Matthew 6:31-33)**
- “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” **(Matthew 11:28-30)**
- “The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field.” **(Matthew 13:44)**
- “Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” **(Matthew 28:18-20)**
- “...whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.” **(Mark 10:44-45)**
- “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.” **(John 3:16)**
- “A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.” **(John 13:34-35)**

Early Church Teachings

- ...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... **(Romans 3:23)**
- For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. **(Romans 6:23)**
- But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. **(Romans 5:8)**
- Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. **(Philippians 2:3-4)**
- Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. **(Philippians 4:8)**
